# **New York Recognizes Pool Openings as Necessary Service**

After hearing from multiple sources that pool openings would be considered essential by New York State, we received the following communication this evening from Empire State Development:

Businesses that provide "essential services necessary to maintain the safety, sanitation and essential operations of residences or other businesses" including general maintenance are deemed essential. While this does not explicitly mention service related to the opening and maintaining swimming pools, it would include any service to ensure the safety, sanitation and general operations of the residence or building.

The information we provided to the ESD perfectly aligns with the definition laid out above. Members can click the links below to access copies of the information we provided the state that communicates the industry consensus that **pool openings are part of necessary service for safety and sanitation of the residence.** It is recommended that you keep a copy of this email and the provided documents in your vehicles to demonstrate why your work is considered essential.
